A staple of the Lincoln Haymarket, you can enjoy coffee and baked goods inside or outside on the "dock."



The Sitch (1140 O St)

Elevated bar food and cocktails in a retro atmosphere.

Pro tip: Open Tuesday-Saturday until midnight

Kate Martin (735 O St)

An intimate speakeasy with creative craft cocktails. Each cocktail is named after a famous Nebraskan.

Our favorite: The Willa Cather
